

Knitted Shell Edging (Worked over a multiple of 6 sts):



SPECIAL ABBREVIATION:

M5 (make 5 stitches in next stitch) = ([K1, P1] twice, K1) all in next stitch OR ([K1, yarn over] twice, K1) all in next stitch.

Work Edging beginning on Right Side of work: * Bind off next st, M5; TURN; P5, sl next st (= last st on left hand needle), hold yarn in front of work (Wrong Side); TURN; K2tog, ** [move st just made back to left hand needle and Knit it] twice, K1, pass first st on needle over 2nd st; rep from ** 2 more times; [move st just made back to left hand needle and Knit it] twice, K2tog, pass first st on needle over 2nd st; bind off 2 sts; rep from * across.

Crocheted Shell Edging (Worked over a multiple of 4 sts plus 1 st):



Work Edging beginning on Right Side of work: Ch 1, sc in first st, * skip next st, ([dc, ch 1] twice, dc) all in next st, skip next st, sc in next st; rep from * across.

ABBREVIATIONS: ch = chain; dc = double crochet; K = knit; P = purl; rep = repeat; sc = single crochet; sl = slip; st(s) = stitch (es); tog = together; * OR ** = repeat whatever follows the * or ** as indicated; [] = work directions in brackets the number of times specified.
