

Long Leaf Scarf

Designed by Jennifer Hansen

Works up in a snap with bulky yarn and a Hairpin Lace loom

Materials

Yarn A: **Rowan Biggy Print #264** (Jewel)

Yarn B: **Rowan Big Wool #007** (Smoky)

Size P – 11.5mm crochet hook

Size L – 8 mm crochet hook

Hairpin Lace Loom

Tapestry Needle

Gauge

With A and larger hook – 11 lps = 4"

Take time to save time, check your gauge.

PROJECT NOTES

Scarf is created as a single hairpin lace strip that is then edged in the round with sc and picot sts. The middle of the strip is then embellished by doing slip sts through the center of the braid.

Use guidelines when creating your strip to avoid a tangled strip prior to edging.

MAIN SCARF BODY

Set hairpin lace loom to 4.5" wide. With A and larger hook, create a strip that is approx 54" long (148 loops).

EDGE SCARF

With B and smaller hook, attach B with slip st to any untwisted loop near the center of the strip.
[Ch 3, sl st in 4th lp from hook, sc in next untwisted loop.] to end.
Ch 2, (ch 3 sl st in 4th lp from hook, ch 2) sc in first st on opposite side of strip (turn keeping RS of scarf facing) then [Ch 3, sl st in 4th lp from hook, sc in next untwisted loop.] to end.

Ch 2, (ch 3 sl st in 4th lp from hook, ch 2) sc in first st on opposite side of strip (turn keeping RS of scarf facing) then [Ch 3, sl st in 4th lp from hook, sc in next untwisted loop] until first loop worked, sl st to first st.

SURFACE EMBELLISH

With B on the WS and smaller hook, hold scarf with RS facing. Make a slip knot and bring through the chain space created by the B edging, placing it around the hook on the RS of the fabric. Insert hook through the sts at the middle of the hairpin lace strip, right near the edge, and pull up a loop of B.
Keeping working yarn to WS, continue to insert hook through the middle sts of the hairpin strip, pulling up a loop of B and bringing through the loop on the hook to form a slip stitch ridge in the middle of the scarf.
Work slip stitches even and straight, not too loose and not too tight until the end of the scarf.
Pull the last loop of B through the ch sp created by the B edging on the strip and through the last loop on hook to secure.

Weave in All ends.
