

Blossom Scarf

Scarf incorporates 3 color Tunisian and fun edgings in standard crochet, resulting in a truly unique scarf.

MODA DEA® “Gleam™”: 1 ball, 3552 Amethyst CA.

RED HEART® Ltd. “Rag Doll™”: 2 balls, 5346 Skip CB.

RED HEART® Ltd. “Bijou™”: 1 ball, 3638 Peridot CC.

Tunisian Q Hook (or Standard Hook w/ rubber band at end).

Crochet Hook 6.5mm [US K-10.5].

Tapestry Needle.

NOTES:

- This scarf is worked even in 3 Color Tunisian. A 2-colored edging (double chain edge) is applied around the scarf, one color at a time. Winding stitch fringe is applied to the short ends of the scarf.

- The fun of 3 Color Tunisian™ is mixing texture and color to create a fabric that is interwoven and complex with no additional ends to weave. The technique uses basic Tunisian Stitch sts, the trick is knowing how to change colors at every pass.
- Working into starting chain through the back hump will result in a nearly identical edge as a Tunisian bind-off.

INSTRUCTIONS:

With Q hook and CA, ch 10.

Row 1 (Right Side): Working into back hump of ch, pull up lp in 2nd ch from hook and in each ch across – 10 lps on hook; drop CA; with CB yarn over and draw through 1 lp, * yarn over and draw through 2 lps; rep from * to last 2 lps; drop CB, with CC yarn over and draw through 2 lps remaining on hook.

Row 2: With CC, skip first vertical bar, draw up a lp in next vertical bar and in each vertical bar across – 10 lps; drop CC, pick up CA and draw through 1 lp, * yarn over and draw through 2 lps; rep from * to last 2 lps; drop CA, pick up CB and draw through 2 lps remaining on hook.

Row 3: With CB work same as Row 2 across, drop CB, pick up CC and work lps off hook as before changing to CA to work off last 2 lps.

Rep Rows 1-3 until approximately 54” from beginning, end Row 3.

Next Row: With CB skip first vertical bar, sl st under 2nd vertical bar and under each vertical bar across. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

Edging-Rnd 1: With right side facing and 6.5mm hook, join CC to 2nd row end from beginning of scarf; * ch 5, skip next row end, sc around edge st of next row end; rep from * to last row end before corner; ch 5, * sc in next st, ch 10, mark last ch made; ch 3, [*working loosely, yarn over and draw up a lp under ch-3 just made*] 9 times, yarn over and draw through all lps on hook, sl st in marked ch – **winding stitch dangle** made; ch 10, sc in same st as last sc worked on scarf **, 2 sc in each of the next 3 sts; rep from * to last stitch before next corner, end at **; ch 5, skip corner, sc in 2nd row end

from corner; work long edge and next short edge as before; join with a sl st to first st. Fasten off.

Rnd 2: With right side facing and 6.5mm hook, join CA in first skipped row end; ch 5, * drop lp from hook, insert hook in next ch-5 of CC and into dropped lp, sc in next skipped row end, ch 5; rep from * to corner; drop lp from hook, insert hook under first winding stitch dangle and into dropped lp, skip first 2 sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, ch 5, make winding stitch dangle, ch 5, sc in same st as last sc, sc in each of next 2 sc, drop lp from hook, insert hook under next winding stitch dangle and into dropped lp, skip next 2 sc, sc in next 3 sc, ch 5, make winding stitch dangle, ch 5, sc in same st as last sc, sc in each of next 4 sc, ch 5, drop lp from hook, insert hook under next winding stitch dangle and into dropped lp and work down next long edge and next short edge as before; join. Fasten off. Weave in ends.

(6 Super Bulky) **RED HEART® Ltd. “Bijou™”**, Art. E729 (1.76 ounce/84 yard ball)
